

**Notice to interested persons entitled to sign
an application for approval by way of referendum**

1. Further to the public consultation meeting held on August 11, 2026, the Greenfield Park Borough Council adopted the following second draft By-law:

- The second draft of *By-law GP-2026-177 modifying By-law GP-2025-170 relating to urban planning, in order to correct, adjust and clarify certain provisions.*

This second draft By-law concerns the entire territory of the Borough.

Articles 5, 7, and 12 of the second draft By-law contain provisions that are subject to approval by way of referendum.

2. This second draft By-law contains one or some provisions that are subject to approval by way of referendum. Interested persons of concerned zones and their contiguous zones may require that this By-law be submitted to the approval of some qualified voters, in accordance with the *Act Respecting Elections and Referendums in Municipalities* (RLRQ, c. E-2.2).

3. Conditions for an application to be valid

To be valid, all applications must:

- indicate clearly the object of the disposition and the zone it originates from;
- be signed by at least 12 interested persons from the zone it originates from or by at least the majority of them if the number of interested persons does not exceed 21. Any document, sent individually or through a petition, will be accepted pending verifications;
- be received by email at the address greffe.gp@longueuil.quebec, at the latest on September 4, 2026.

4. Interested persons

Information concerning these provisions and qualified voters in the zones affected and those in any contiguous zone from which a valid application originates may be obtained by writing to the email address greffe.gp@longueuil.quebec.

5. Lack of applications

If the provisions stated in paragraph 1 are not the object of any valid application, they will be included in a zoning By-law which will not be approved by qualified voters.
